

Several of the GSS booklets deal with climate change and as such are great resources for incorporating in a variety of courses, including Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Earth Science, Environmental Science, Mathematics, Social Studies, or Integrated Science. The series was in fact designed as an integrated (interdisciplinary) science course. Each book features societal issues that need science for full understanding, background material, investigations (in–class labs or at home), and virtual field trip to a place where the science is happening (including interviews with scientists that are good role models for high school students).
