Life Lines for High School meeting on Feb 1, 2011

Alan Gould sent me a link to set up a Leader Page, on the home website above, so I set up a short introduction for the page. I will add a link to our google sites page when we have it up and working.

During the meeting, we each introduced ourselves and shared a little about where we were with our PLC. Most of the PLC's were having issues with meetings. They could not meet in one spot, so they were trying different venues, such as skypes, conference calls and using Alan's phone in/log in setup. Many have not actually had meetings with their members yet. The few who had met were working on establishing curriculum for the program. They had set up assignments for each meeting: first working on the big ideas, then standards, then units and finally lessons and activities for high school classes.

The groups are still on the big ideas and standards phase at this time. We did ask that the groups post their work to the leaders page as it is accumulated, so that we can all share. That seemed to be a big theme from Alan, that as we develop curriculum, we post it on the leaders page for all to use.

Another thing that Alan wants, is for groups to find guest speakers on Climate Change and share their presentations to the rest of the leaders, by audio Power Points or videos, and even share presenters when possible.

I feel that we are on the right track with our PLC. We discussed presenting a working curriculum to middle and high school teachers during the GSTA conference next spring. The curriculum and lessons can be posted on our leaders page for others to access, and we can also use items from other PLC's.

Our next step will be to grow our PLC to include more high school and middle school teachers, and even informal educators, in order to build our expertise and develop our presentation. On that note, we must have 7 active members before the stipends will be released.
